RV-6 IN PROGRESS

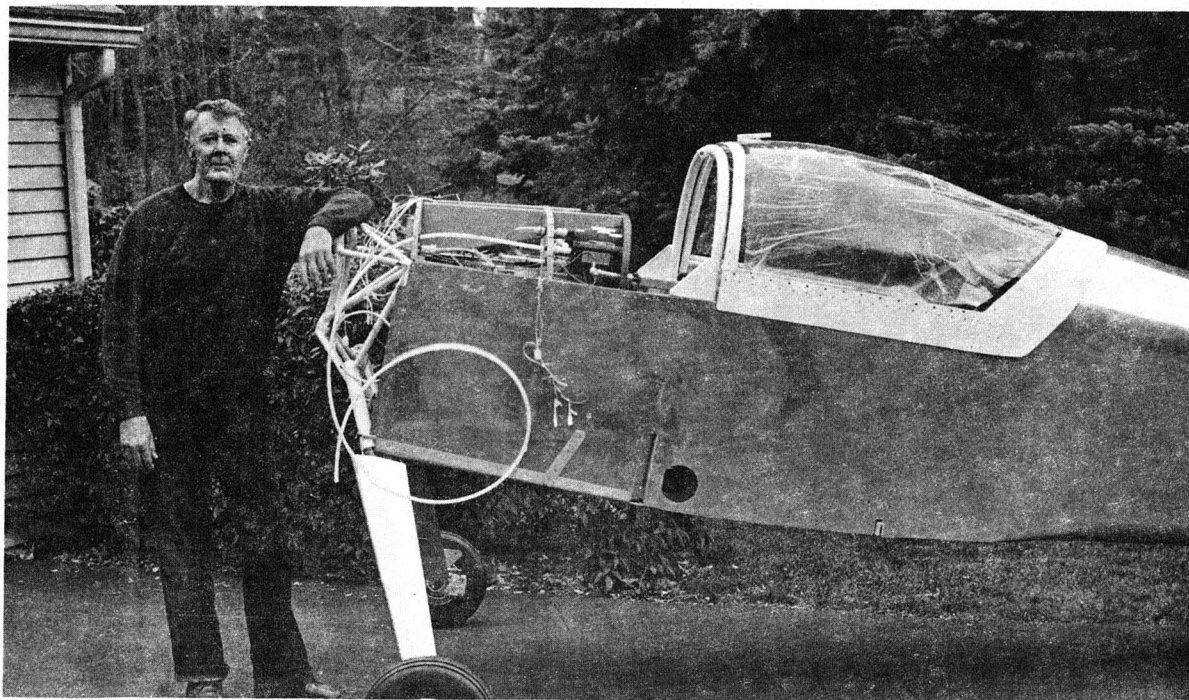
